

The Jesuit Historical Institute (*Institutum Historicum Societatis Iesu - IHSI*) was founded in 1930 under Father General Włodimir Ledóchowski. Over the years its members in Rome oversaw the publication of the biannual review *Archivum Historicum Societatis Iesu (AHSI)*, the *Monumenta Historica Societatis Iesu (MHSI)*, the monograph series *Bibliotheca Instituti Historici Societatis Iesu (BIHSI)*, and the series *Subsidia ad historiam Societatis Iesu (SAHSI)*.

In the light of Father General Adolfo Nicolás's letter of 25 February 2010 to the major superiors of the Society (published in *Acta Romana Societatis Iesu*, vol. XXIV (2010), pp. 931-933), the apostolate of Jesuit history at the Curia in Rome was reconstituted within the context of the Archives (*Archivum Romanum Societatis Iesu - ARSI*). Henceforth *ARSI* was given an expanded mission. Among its competences is to oversee publications relating to the Society's history. Thus the historical publications continue as part of *ARSI*, while retaining the publication imprint *IHSI*.
